# flex-table communication in motion









#### flex-table - communication in motion.

Meetings, conferences, presentations, workshops, training sessions, seminars – the importance of communication cannot be understated. But office space doesn't usually grow to match, in fact, quite the opposite: economising on space is the mark of efficient space management. Multifunctional space with a flexible layout helps organisations to be dynamic. The prerequisite for this is furniture that can easily be adapted to different forms of communication. The *flex-table* range has been developed for just this situation.

*flex-table* is beautifully simple in design, yet highly functional.

The design of *flex-table* is based on the demands of modern communication areas: configurations must be quickly set up and modified, handling must be easy, and space-saving storage and an innovative appearance are essential. The tables have castors to ensure a high level of mobility; two of them are fitted with brakes to stop them rolling away inadvertently. The tabletop flips effortlessly. This means that tables that are not wanted can be folded away and parked next to one another to save space. Tabletops come in varying sizes, to accommodate differing communication needs – from meetings to video conferences. A multifunctional media trolley that can house all types of media technology, and a mobile screen with a whiteboard and a notice board complete the range.







A mobile media wall (top) and a multifunctional media trolley (left) complement the *flex-table* range. The media wall is available either with a notice board on both sides or with a notice board and a whiteboard. Relevant accessories are available, such as a notepad clip, flipchart paper and writing utensils. The wall surface measures 121/150 cm and the overall height is 190 cm.

The media trolley is available either with a rectangular top (100/57 cm) or an elliptical top (100/57 cm). The height of the tops is adjustable by a crank handle. Electrical connection is dealt with by a cable box, which opens up to accommodate plug-in boxes and data boxes, as well as having sufficient room for excess cable.

Two of the four castors can be locked – so the flex-table is mobile, but does not roll away inadvertently.

flex-table has a cable box for electrical connection, making it easy to plug equipment in above table level.
